Strength: Regulatory (81%), Language (70%), Gross Motor (75%), Social-Emotional (74%) and Self-Help (75%) at age level or above

Areas of needed growth: Cognitive (69%) and Fine Motor (61%) at age level or above

- **11** On Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)-*written plan created to meet individual needs, concerns and priorities of individual children birth-3 and their families.*

HS includes 6/7 domains (Regulatory/Sensory imbedded in other strands) *Report shows data due to 3 children transitioning from Early Head Start.*

Strength: Gross Motor (87%), Fine Motor (80%), Language (87%), Social-Emotional (95%) and Self-Help (89%) at age level or above

Areas of needed growth: Cognitive (74%) at age level or above
